### SO...WHAT IS A RESIST?

"Resist" means that the crayon will repel the watercolor away from it. The paint will be absorbed by the paper, but cannot be absorbed in the areas where the waxy crayon was applied. So, even though you are painting directly over your pastel patterns, they still show up just as bright and beautiful. (HINT: Use a white crayon for a few patterns, and watch what happens as you paint over them!)

# LINE




A path created by a moving point, mark or object.

There are many types of lines: thick, thin, horizontal, vertical, zigzag, diagonal, curly, curved, spiral, etc. and are often very expressive. Lines are basic tools for artists.






